## TACTIC Workshop 1 for Case Study 1: Terrorism in Europe

As part of the TACTIC research project, on 10 February 2015, Trilateral Research and Consulting will host the first workshop on preparedness for terrorism in Europe. The workshop will focus particularly on the risk of terrorism in London. The workshop is one of four initially being held as part of the project's case studies focusing on terrorism, floods, pandemics and earthquakes. A second series of workshops will be held, commencing October 2015. The workshops will be used to;

- Gain input and feedback on the development of a community preparedness audit, enabling communities to assess how prepared they are
- Receive feedback on a catalogue of good practices of communication and education for preparedness and to identify the types of material and practices required to increase preparedness to acts of terrorism
- Gain input into the development of a training and learning web-based platform for learning about preparedness for large-scale and cross-border disasters
